Sara Lane Prefers Anonymity



"WHAT I WANT is land . . . enough land, clear and free. I'd like to be able to have land that's ours, big enough to have people stay with us and to live comfortably. I'd like to have an extra room for sewing and enough room for horses."

These are some of the dreams of Sara Lane, Bronx-born actress who plays the equestrian granddaughter in NBC-TV's *The Virginian* [Wednesdays, 6:30-8 p. m., channel 5].

WHEN SHE isn't dreaming, the 18-year-old Miss Lane is busy taking life seriously, avoiding discotheques, Hollywood glamor and automobiles.

"I'd love to live in an era without cars, electric lights, and the tape recorder," she confesses. "I'm scared stiff of cars. Yes, I was in an accident once, but I think I was scared of them before that. I'm scared of collisions, but I'm not sure why."

SHE CALLS herself an inveterate snob, thinks she's pretty and asserts that in Hollywood where competition is very keen for television roles "I think it was my looks which got me the part."

Like most entertainers she likes her fan mail and gets "a kick" out of being recognized by the public, but like Miss Garbo before her, she says "I prefer anonymity to crowds of people."






