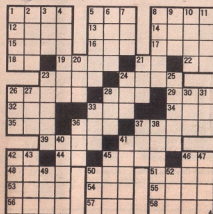

Anna and the King seems to be flopping at 6:30 p.m. Sundays, so CBS brings on a special featuring the Jackson 5, one of the hottest acts in teendom. This hour-long program, which is probably a pilot for a future CBS variety series, features Arte Johnson and Johnny Brown and is produced

by Allan Blye and Chris Bearde, who also give us the Sonny and Cher Show.

TUESDAY: Election Coverage. 5:30 p.m. on Channel 2 (CBS). 6 p.m. on Channels 5 (NBC) and 7 (ABC). If the polls are to be believed, all three networks may end their election eve shows at 6:02 p.m. Whatever happens, Howard K. Smith and Harry Reasoner are the anchormen for ABC, with Walter Cronkite at CBS and John Chancellor and David Brinkley at NBC fulfilling similar roles. Can the networks predict who will be President within 30 seconds of the closing of the polls? Tune in!

WEDNESDAY: Madigan. 7:30 p.m. Channel 5 (NBC). The premiere of this detective series starring Richard Widmark was one of the best new series on TV, filled with tension and a real feeling for the city of New York. In his second show, Widmark moves to London to help Scotland Yard break up a gang headed by an American mobster. Universal was filming this episode in London just one month ago, meaning that the film will hardly be dry from the developing room when we see it on TV.

As a cop, Eddie Egan had to act--to survive

THE best amateur actor in the history of the New York City Police Department is now doing well as a professional television and movie performer.

"I had to go into the movies to get promoted," said former detective Eddie Egan, who plays a police lieutenant in Paramount's new crime thriller, "Badge 373."

Eddie, whose real-life exploits were the basis for the award-winning film, "The French Connection," is the legendary detective who made 8,741 arrests during a 19-year career as a crime-solver.

This amazing total is a record for the New York police, and, Egan said, "so far as we could find in a study made before I retired, it is a world record in detection."

EDDIE, a maverick detective sometimes in trouble with his superiors because of his unorthodox methods, retired last year because he was "tired of paper work," and because he had always yearned for an acting career.

He feels he has smoothed out his

quarrels with the Police Department. He has his badge, and is still permitted to wear strapped to his right ankle the gun he wore while in service. And, beginning in 1975, he will start receiving annual retirement pay of \$11,000, which is 42 per cent of his final salary as a detective.

DEFENDING the brusque tactics he employed which on duty — he wasn't noted for following departmental rules to the letter — Egan remarked:

"An old cop once told me, 'The only trouble you can get into on this job is by doing the job.' I found out myself that when you're arresting eight to 10 people a day, you become maybe too experienced. You cut the corners too close sometimes to please everybody."

Anyway, Eddie feels his future is pretty bright. He has a contract with Paramount tying him to the production of 13 films for which he has submitted plot outlines. Also in prospect is a television series, tentatively entitled *My Partner and I*.

"Hopefully, I'll play myself," said Egan, "but that's being negotiated."

THERE are sound reasons for Eddie's optimism. He has already played six professional roles, and behind him lie innumerable real-life roles while he was a detective, in some of which his own safety was at stake.

Egan, now 42, stands an inch above six feet, weighs 225 pounds, has wavy brown hair and intense blue eyes, and looks like a retired pro football fullback. He said there was considerable difference between acting for the Police Department and for Hollywood.

"The pay is nicer now, but acting is literally a matter of survival when I was a detective. In some places, if they knew you were a cop, you'd end up with too many holes in your head."

BUT EDDIE thinks his most successful role was as a street Santa Claus. Dressed in a Santa costume he led his partners into two Harlem hangouts for drug addicts.

"We knocked over both joints and made 37 arrests in about half an hour," he recalled.

The acting ended when Eddie had to grapple to the floor an addict who had drawn a gun on one of his partners. Looking at the struggling figures, a junkie moaned, "We've lost it all now — even Santa Claus has joined the cops." (AP)

When you're hot, you're hot--that's Carroll O'Connor

CARROLL O'CONNOR is the hottest thing in television today.

His CBS-TV All in the Family series, in which he plays the bigot Archie Bunker, has been No. 1 again in the national video program ratings—about par for the course.

He starred recently in CBS-TV's adaptation of the Pulitzer Prize winning musical satire "Of Thee I Sing," portraying a presidential candidate who runs on a campaign of love.

He is a sure-fire nightclub attraction because he can sing acceptably and entertain as more than just Archie.

He is a literate, intelligent and sought-after guest for television talk shows.

HE'S into the record album field, thanks to All in the Family, and not just with an album having to do with the series and its cast, but also as a singer with a nostalgia-oriented approach.

A respected character actor in films for some time, he is also a writer. And it's reported that a movie he has written, "Little Angie Always," is expected to be made in Italy next spring.

He lived in Rome for a while, and the movie, which a spokeswoman says he may direct or act in, is said to be about Americans in that city.

O'CONNOR also has another big special set for CBS-TV: a 90-minute, March 3 music, comedy and drama outing entitled "It's a Man's World—Or Is It?", and expected to deal

with male-female relationships.

The spokeswoman says O'Connor will display his music, comedy and drama talents in the various segments. And recent plans were that he would also be represented on the show by a dramatic playlet written by him.

In addition, CBS-TV says another special starring O'Connor—in an interview-type program in which he would portray Revolutionary War figure Samuel Adams—has been in the negotiation stage for next season.

This would be in the vein of a CBS-TV hour seen last year, "A Conversation with Lord North," in which Eric Seavard "interviewed" a British figure of the Revolutionary War period, played by Peter Ustinov.

It is reported that Ustinov is to appear in another "interview," as Britain's king during the American Revolution, George III.

This series of occasional broadcasts, assuming they continue, is obviously keyed to the upcoming U.S. bicentennial, and is entitled "The American Revolution: 1770-1793."

BACK AT All in the Family, the show is so hot that Variety columnist Army Archer wrote a while ago that the series' boss, Norman Lear, said nearly all major Hollywood studios want it for movies.

Furthermore, according to that report, such companies as General Motors and International Telephone & Telegraph would like the Bunker family to do "in-house" film shorts.

Archie really has started something. (UPI)

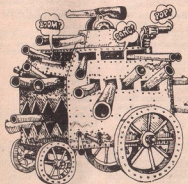

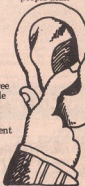
