**SUNDAY:** The Wonderful World of Walt Disney. 6:30 p.m. Channel 5 (NBC). "Nature's Better Built Homes," a live-action adventure, looks at the way animals build their dwellings.

**MONDAY:** "The Young Convicts: Prison in the Streets." 7 p.m. Channel 7 (ABC). This is a documentary look at some of the new



methods used to rehabilitate youthful offenders.

**TUESDAY:** "Blue Collar Worker." 8:30 p.m. Channel 5 (NBC). A documentary on the country's young blue-collar workers. The purpose is to see what is on the minds of the "noncollege educated generation who work in factories," NBC says.

**B**IG Raymond Burr is just that. Big. Six-two and 280 pounds, after dieting. "I've had a weight problem since the day I was born," he shrugs. "I was a big baby." The way his metabolism goes, he adds, he can put on pounds on the same amount of food that wouldn't add an ounce on skinny folks. "Even just one meal a day — but I lose weight working. Don't get a chance to eat much."

● **TODAY'S** TV comics are lightweight, contends irascible Jack

Cartier. "The major comics gave way to peanut-butter-and-jelly comedy because a top comic is a terrible furnace to feed." So now, he told Morton Moss, "we have a lot of fey, precious comedians — funny, but second bananas." Even so, this is better than when "they tried to make singers comics — funny Andy Williams, hilarious Glen Campbell."

● **COMEDIAN** Marty Feldman says he's quite happy if his show turns out to be 85 per cent as good as he hoped. "I'm reasonably happy at 50 per cent — and depressed at 40. Then I know I've come nowhere near what I set out to do." . . . **Charles Bronson** wonders if his "Valachi Papers" may not do so well after "The Godfather." "Who knows? The public may be sick of the Mafia," he says.

● **JEAN STAPLETON** works long days as Edith Bunker. But she puts her own real-life family first, getting up early enough to make breakfast for hubby Bill Putch and the kids, John, 12, and Pam, 10. "It gives me a chance to be there, and to talk to them and listen to what they have to say. I also fix their school lunches. I think it's important they know their mother made them, don't you?"

● **Lauren Bacall** did Cactus Flower for two years, then launched into "Applause," and she admits that maybe she's kind of nuts. "I'm the kind of actress who always gets nervous. I'll say to myself, 'As many

times as you've done this show, how can you be upset?' But it doesn't help." People backstage are warned not to tell her if a friend is out front. Even so, she says, "I think people who don't have nerves are boring to watch."

● **PETER FALK** got hooked on art while doing "The Prisoner of Second Avenue." Neil Simon's season-long sellout, on Broadway. But he'll have to give it all up for three months while he does next season's Columbo, the sloppy-but-brilliant cop. "It's up at 6 a.m. every day and 11 or 12 hours on the set every day for 11 days for each episode, one right after the other, for seven episodes. Just no time."

● **ABC-TV** president James Duffy

has laid down the law on on-air promotion. No more being "the twin brother of motion picture trailers" by lifting scenes out of context for dramatic moments. ● **Paul Winchell** pulls his dummy sidekick Jerry Mahoney out of a dusty suitcase for his, or their, new Saturday-morning children's game show on NBC this fall. "Jerry's going to have to learn an entirely new vocabulary to keep up with today's youngsters," says Winchell.

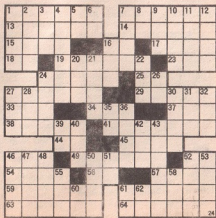
