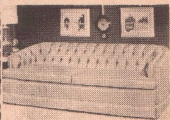

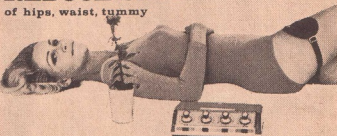

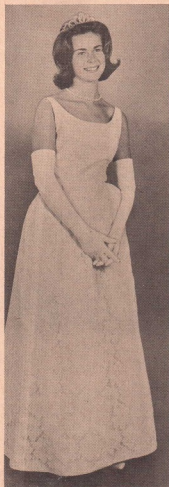

All the World's a Stage to Jack Paar

PADDLING in a pirogue [a hollowed-out log] or "whirly-birding" in a helicopter is all the same to Jack Paar. Just so long as it moves seems to be Paar's attitude as he journeys to many of the almost inaccessible parts of the globe in order to present a vivid and accurate picture of our world to the nation's armchair globetrotters.

For the 1964-65 season, the Jack Paar colorcasts will show films Paar shot this summer during his 1,000-mile trip by plane and small craft up the Amazon river. On the trip the performer was accompanied by his wife, Miriam, and daughter, Randy.

HIS FAMILY did not accompany him however when he went to the Solomon Islands in 1962 to report on the PT-109 incident in the life of President Kennedy. "That was the longest, hardest trip I ever made," Paar commented.

Despite the occasional inconveniences, Paar enjoys his camera's-eye view of the world. He's flown in a helicopter over such cities as London, Rome, Athens, and Jerusalem. He's filmed from a gondola in Venice and on a street in Moscow. He's made tours of East and West Africa, including his memorable three-day visit with Dr. Schweitzer at Lambaréne.

Probably his favorite home away from home is England, and he usually manages to jet the Atlantic at least once a TV season. This year is no exception.

IN NOVEMBER, Paar will spend two weeks in England to tape two shows which will be telecast on Nov. 13 and Nov. 20. Incidentally, Paar has done more shows from England [45] than any other United States TV star.

Paar is currently at work on a book based on his travel experiences titled "Three on a Toothbrush," which will be published by Doubleday.

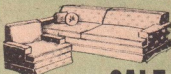
